

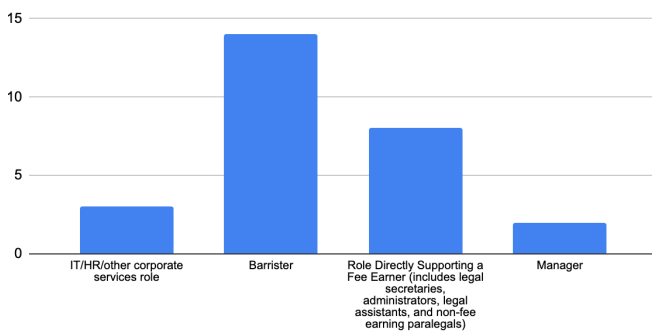


Diversity Monitoring Report July 2025

Role in Firm

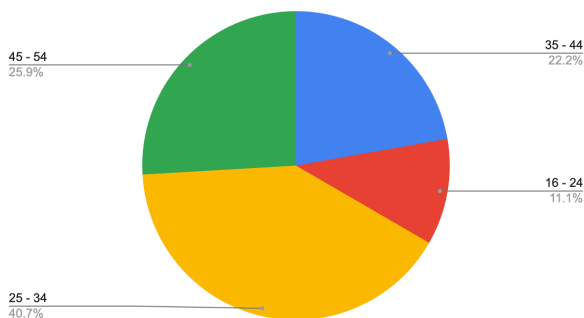


Count of Select one category which best describes your role in the firm.

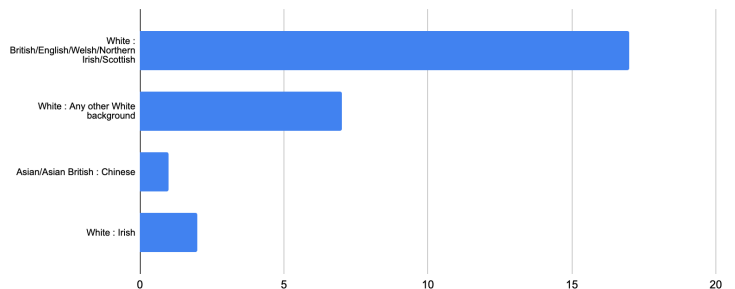
Sex



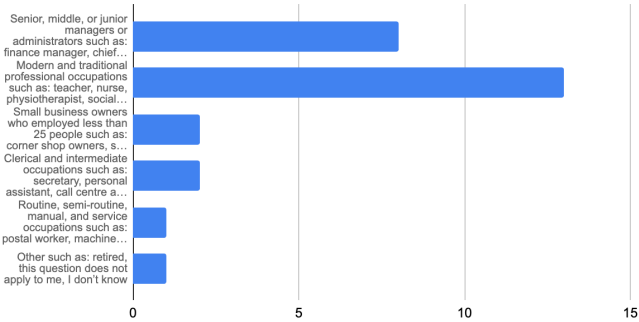
Age Category



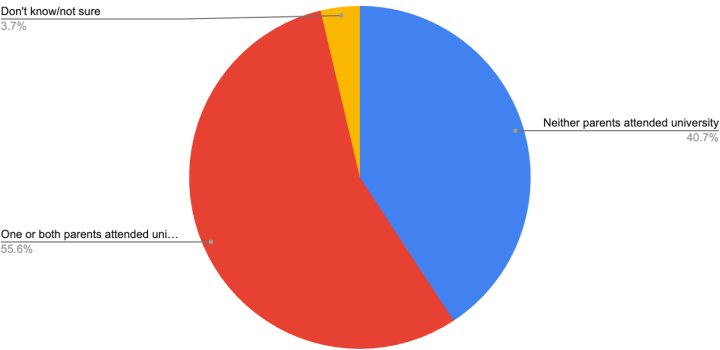
Ethnic Group



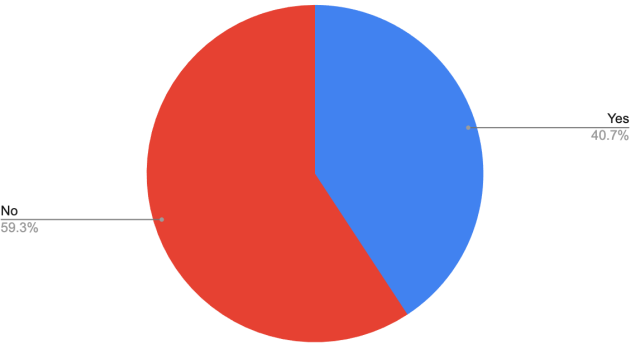
Occupation of your main household earner when you were aged about 14?



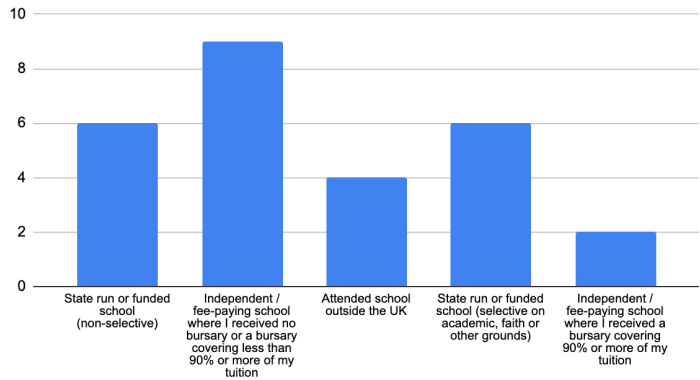
First Generation to Attend University
